Discussion Questions

- Think of a time when you were lost and needed directions or were looking for something at a store and needed help. Share what you remember about the person who lent you a hand.
- 2. Carefully read Romans 10:14–15. Process with your family or Life Group the importance of us disciples having the "feet of those who preach the good news." What does that even mean?
- 3. Often when we see the disciple Andrew in the Gospels, he is taking people to Jesus. He is attentive to the people around him and available to take them to the Lord. What might it look like to be more attentive to those around you? Give thought to ways you can introduce people to Jesus.
- 4. Identify six people you can pray for to come to a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. Pray specifically for the Lord to help you see opportunities to personally take each one to Jesus.
- 5. Invite someone to New Hope Church's Community Picnic on Saturday, August 19, 11am–3pm. This is great way to develop relationships with neighbors in the community and take people to Jesus.
