DISCUSSION questions

1. Do you know anyone who responded to the gospel who seemed like the “least likely” person to follow Jesus?
2. What is an accepted attitude or behavior in your profession that you need to walk away from in order to follow Jesus’ values more fully?
3. What does leaving everything to follow Jesus look like? Based on scripture, what does this mean in regard to jobs, home, money, friendships?
4. How can you use your home to invite people in your sphere of influence to experience Jesus as host?
5. Describe a time when grumbling has taken place against people for giving time and attention to those who don’t yet celebrate Jesus.
6. What would need to change in your life for you to be characterized as “someone who eats and drinks with tax collectors and sinners” in order to help them be with Jesus?
7. Read Isaiah 57:15-21 and 1 Timothy 1:12-17. Pray for yourself AND others who have needs and are spiritually sick to repent and experience Jesus’ healing touch.
