DISCUSSION questions

- 1. Tell about a time you made a promise or commitment and didn't fulfill it. What were the consequences for you, your character and others who may have been affected?
- 2. We've seen how God, in his complete sovereignty, specifically fulfilled prophecy. How does this impact your view of pain, loss and chaos in your life, our nation and our world?
- 3. Allow these gospel promises of God to wash over you as you read them out loud: Isaiah 43:1–7; Jeremiah 31:31–34; Zechariah 3:1–10.
- 4. We've seen throughout Luke how Jesus runs to those in the margins, the lost, the neglected. How have you seen your heart changed in regard to lost people around you? Is there someone you're feeling led to bring to church this Easter weekend? Pray together for opportunities to invite them.
- 5. What's a step of obedience you need to take that could be risky or costly? What steps can you take as a group to walk alongside one other in encouraging obedience?
