DISCUSSION questions

- 1. Is there an adoption or foster care connection in your life? Yourself? In your family? A friend? A neighbor? Share the story.
- 2. Our calling to serve the fatherless is grounded in the reality that God has adopted us. Read Galatians $3:\!25\!-\!29$ and $4:\!4\!-\!7$ and discuss who we were before Christ and what God has done for us.
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 24:17–22 and Psalm 82:3–4. From God's perspective, what does justice for the fatherless look like?
- 4. What are your anxieties or hesitations about personally caring for children in crisis, whether in a "front lines" role or a "wrap-around" role?
- 5. Share something that impacted you as Bob, Emily and Isaiah Reis shared their story.
- 6. Pray together for God to care for children who don't have a home.
