2. In verse 1, Paul refers to himself as a slave. What are the implications of knowing that you are owned by Jesus? Specifically, how is the gospel revealed to others because you are completely owned by Him?
3. In what areas in your life do you desire to experience God's overwhelming joy and love? See 1 Corinthians 13:1-13. How does this influence the experiences or memories that can be made with those around you?
4. Read Philippians 1:6. How does Paul's confidence in Christ in the midst of earthly difficulties impact and encourage you?
5. In what ways can you leverage real hardships in your life to glorify and praise God?
