### Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever thought that God owed you a better life? What does that conversation sound like in your head? Or in your prayers?
2. How have you experienced corporate worship as a re-orienting of your thoughts, feelings and aspirations?
3. Read Psalm 73:16–17 & Hebrews 10:19–25. How does this New Testament passage inform and complete what Asaph saw as he came into the sanctuary?
4. Read Psalm 73:25–26. Confess to one another how you have not made God your portion and your primary desire. Pray for one another to experience the assurance of forgiveness through the cross and protection from this idolatry.

Family Question: What are some practical ways that we as a family could express that our greatest desire and source of joy is God? How could this mindset impact how we relate to those around us who are without Christ?
