Discussion Questions

1. Is there a foster or adoption story in your life? Share it with your group.
2. Read Genesis 1:26-28. Everyone we meet bears the same image of God that we ourselves reflect. Have you ever helped someone but felt like you received more from them than you gave? How did God reveal Himself to you in that time?
3. How do you personally respond in love to the groans of vulnerable children, both the unborn and the born? If you feel unprepared or unqualified to help, ask God to guide you and equip you for this work.
4. How far are you willing to be compelled by the love of Christ? What is God asking you to do in response to this message? Take time in prayer to examine your heart. If you feel a resistance to giving Christ everything, talk to God about it. Make the hard choice to yield those areas of your life to Him.
