Discussion Questions

1. Share about a time when you gave a gift that wasn't well received.
2. In both Isaiah 5:1-7 and Mark 12:1-12, God takes the initiative to create the vineyard. He is exceedingly generous. What does this tell you about God's heart toward His creation and those who dwell in it?
3. Think of your prayer requests during the past week. What do they reveal about your desires? Do you want the Son or do you want the vineyard with its comforts and riches?
4. The tenants killed the Son, thinking they were preserving the inheritance for themselves. Read Romans 8:16-17. What path does God give to us to gain the inheritance? What does it mean for us to be co-heirs with Christ?
5. Take a moment to think of two people in your life who do not know Jesus. Pray for them together as a group. Commit to pray for them every day until Easter. Pray also for God to give you opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with them during this time.
