

# Be the Garment of Christ

Mark 5:25-34 || Pastor Matthew St. John || May 27, 2018

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## Discussion Questions

1. Describe a time when you were interrupted from an activity to meet the needs of another person. How did you receive the interruption?
2. **Garments cling as closely as possible.** James 4:8 declares, "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you." What steps have you taken this past week to draw near to God? How have you experienced Him drawing near to you? How does this influence the way that you will live out next week?
3. The woman in Mark 5:33-34 came to Jesus with fear, need, confession and faith. How does Jesus provide for her? Is there anything you would like to freshly trust Him with?
4. **Garments are seen, but hardly noticed. They point to the one who wears them.** How has your life pointed to Christ in the past week? What specific steps can we take to use our lives to make Christ look good?
5. **Garments can get worn out.** When have you felt worn out as you follow Christ? Read Matthew 11:28-30. How have you learned to depend on Christ and find restoration?
